**Honda Cadets**

At the start of the second lap Keifer Steyn tried to get into the inside of Frazer Huntley at gate corner and the two clashed. Huntley retired on the spot while Steyn dropped down the field. Darren Patrick took over third position closely followed by novice Luke Geddes and they finished in this order. Chris Walker finished fifth with the recovering Steyn sixth.

### **Senior Max**

Andrew Buchan got the best start and Grant Cheesewright followed him from the second row ahead of Alistair Smith from outside of the front row. These three opened up a gap over the rest of the field. This order was maintained until half distance after Smith was pushing Cheesewright hard got to the inside at gate corner. Smith took after Buchan who held on to take the victory. A group of six drivers, Cliff Harper, Gordon Hawton, Michael Christie, Neil Ferguson, Ian Duncan and Richard Johnstone were involved in a close tussle. On lap 5 Cliff Harper began having accelerator problems and Gordon Hawton was able to get through and escape from the pack to take fourth. Harper had to visit the pits to have the accelerator stop bolt adjusted. This allowed Ferguson to come through to take fifth with Michael Christie sixth. Duncan and Johnstone took the next two places.

A family double occurred when Gordon Rennie presented both the Kenny McKay Shield and JRD Cup to bothers Bruce and Andrew Buchan for scoring lease points on the day.

Next race meeting at Boyndie will take place on Sunday 24<sup>th</sup> May with the racing starting at 11:00.
